Working on behalf of the Helena Symphony and as a member of the Artistic Administration, the Hospitality Coordinator assist with housing, transportation, and meals for musicians of the Helena Symphony Orchestra, and guest artists.

SPECIFIC DUTIES

- Coordinates housing needs for musicians of the Helena Symphony Orchestra
- Cultivates volunteers to host musicians and assist in airport transportation of guest artists
- ✤ Requests complimentary tickets for hosts, as needed
- Orders and delivers meals for specific rehearsals
- Serves as support staff for Symphony Under the Stars by arranging and delivering meals for staff and crew and water for volunteers; by working with Carroll College staff and musicians for room assignments; and by preparing dressing rooms for the conductor and guest artists.
- Prepares dressing rooms for conductor and guest artists, including suppling bottled water, and other specific needs indicated by the Director of Artistic Planning
- Periodically serves as an "on-call" staff member for HSO rehearsals
- Other duties as assigned
